

Faculty Senate Committee on Academic Responsibility

2017-2018 Report August 22, 2018

The Committee on Academic Responsibility handled two (2) cases for the 2018-19 school year. One of the cases came from a graduate course in the Darla Moore School of Business and one, from the College of Arts and Sciences. In both cases, the Committee on Academic Responsibility upheld the College Committees' decision that found both students responsible for the Honor Code violation. Each student received appropriate sanctions from the Carolina Judicial Council. One student received a conduct probation for the remainder of their USC career along with a transcript notation for the course where the offense took place. The other student received conduct probation for a period of six months. Both students were assigned to attend the Academic Integrity Workshop.
