Dear Social Security Administration:

I am an F-1 Nonimmigrant Student enrolled at the University of South Carolina. I do not have an on-campus job and I do not have off-campus work authorization. Per SSA Publication No. 05-10181, I do not qualify for a social security number.

However, I want to apply for a driver's license. To do this, I need a rejection letter from the Social Security Administration. Jacquelyn Starks of the Columbia Social Security Administration advised the University of South Carolina that students in this situation should mail a request for a rejection letter.

This letter is my request. You will also find a completed SS-5 application and copies of my passport, visa, I-20, and I-94. Note that I am not including the original documents because I am requesting a rejection letter rather than applying for a social security number, as I know I am ineligible.
