# Data Summary

The International Student Enrollment Report provides an overview of international student enrollment at the University of South Carolina, Columbia campus, for the Fall 2016 term. For reporting purposes, "international" is understood as a non-U.S. citizen who holds a student visa.

Additionally, data is reported on English Programs for Internationals (EPI), the University's intensive English program. EPI data can be found on page 5 of this report.

Information on the International Accelerator Program (IAP), the University's pathway program is also demonstrated in this year's report. IAP is in its 2nd year of operation at USC. There are three categories within IAP: the Extended Accelerator Program, the Academic Accelerator Program, and the Integrated Accelerator Program. The former two, Extended and Academic, initially enter USC as non-degree seeking students, whereas the Integrated students are admitted as fully degree seeking.


