## HOW TO APPLY FOR VETERANS EDUCATION BENEFITS

#### 1. File the Application for the GI-BILL®

- Go to the GI-Bill® website: <a href="http://www.benefits.va.gov/gibill/">http://www.benefits.va.gov/gibill/</a>
- Select "Education & Training" on the left side
- Select "For Students", then "Get Started"
- Select "Get Started Home"
- To apply online, select "How to Apply"
  - If you qualify for more than one program, then select "Use the GI Bill® Comparison Tool"
- Click on the "Find your education benefits form" button.
- Select the radial button for "Applying for a new benefit"
- This will initiate more questions. Answer them to continue.
- When "Apply Now" appears, click on that button.
- Follow the directions to complete the application.
- Print a copy for your records.

# 2. Bring to the Financial Aid and Veteran Affairs Office forms needed for your benefits type:

Ch 30, GI-Bill®: A copy of your DD-214 showing an honorable discharge

CH 31 VA Voc. Rehab: A 28-1905 signed by your Case Worker

Ch 33, Post 9-11: A copy of your *DD-214* showing an honorable discharge

Ch 33, Post 9-11 Dependent: A copy of your Certificate of Eligibility

Ch 1606 & 1607 for Reservists: A copy of your NOBE

CH 35 Dependent/Survivor Benefits: A copy of your Certificate of Eligibility For Ch 35 if you are changing schools or your major, you must Select "Updating my program of study or place of training.
