Face-to-Face (Traditional)	TRAD	Course that is taught in a traditional face-to-face classroom setting.	Course meets in-person on Tuesday/Thursday in a classroom on campus.
Blended/Hybrid Up to 49% web	B3WEB	Course that is taught both face-to-face and online with 49% or less of the course offered online.	Course meets in-person on Monday/Wednesday and either: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meets online on Friday with synchronous instruction; or • Activities/assignments are completed asynchronously online by students in lieu of a Friday meeting.
Blended 50% or more web	BWEB	Course that is taught both face-to-face and online with 50% or more of the course offered online.	Course meets in-person on Monday and either: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Most activities/assignments are completed asynchronous online by students on their own time by a specific due date; or • The course meets online with synchronous instruction on Wednesday/Friday
100% Web Asynchronous	DWEB	Course that is taught 100% online in which students complete activities and assignments on their own time to meet course deadlines.	All course materials are provided online and students follow a course schedule with assignments that must be completed by an established due date.
100% Web Synchronous	DWEBS	Course that is taught 100% online in which students are required to participate in online meetings/lectures at specific days and times.	Course meets online on Tuesday/Thursday.
100% Web Mix Asynchronous & Synchronous	DWEBM	Course that is taught 100% online in which students are required to participate in online meetings/lectures at specific days and times and also complete activities & assignments on their own time to meet course deadlines.	Course meets online on Monday and students have additional online activities/ assignments to complete on their own time by a specific due date.

Over 50% Two-Way AV Off-Campus	BTWOF	Course that is taught both face-to-face and via two-way video to off-campus sites with more than 50% of the course via two-way video.	Course that meets in-person on Monday and meets via two-way video delivered to off-campus sites on Wednesday/Friday.
Over 50% Two-Way AV On-Campus	BTWON	Course that is taught both face-to-face and via two-way video to system campuses with more than 50% of the course via two-way video.	Course that meets in-person on Monday and meets via two-way video delivered to system campuses sites on Wednesday/Friday.
Other Distance Delivery	DOTH	Course that is considered an internship, clinical, or practicum course and is part of a 100% online program.	Internship, clinical, or practicum course completed off-campus as part of a 100% online program.
Two-Way AV Off-Campus	DTWOF	Course that is taught via two-way video to off-campus sites.	Course that meets specific days and times via two-way video delivered to off-campus sites.
Two-Way AV On-Campus	DTWON	Course that is taught via two-way video to on-campus sites.	Course that meets specific days and times via two-way video delivered to on-campus sites.
Two-Way AV Between System Campuses	DTWS	Course that is taught via two-way video between system campuses.	Course that meets specific days and times via two-way video delivered between system campus sites.
Palmetto College Course	PLMC	Course that is offered as part of a Palmetto College program.	Palmetto College course
